

Estimated Cost of Attendance (COA) & Anticipated Disbursement Amounts 2025-2026 SAMPLE for JD Flex Track Students beginning studies in Fall 2025

A standardized set of budgets is used as the basis for determining the cost of attendance (COA) at Trinity Law School. COA is the total amount it will cost you to go to school—usually stated as a yearly figure. COA includes tuition and fees; room and board (or a housing and food allowance); and allowances for books, supplies, transportation, loan fees, and dependent care. It also includes miscellaneous and personal expenses, including an allowance for the rental or purchase of a personal computer; costs related to a disability; and reasonable costs for eligible study-abroad programs. You will find an estimated COA calculation below:
