



# JD FLEX TRACK 2019-2020

## Academic Program

To fulfill our commitment to making legal education accessible, we offer a special program to allow students who do not meet our normal admission requirements to attend law school. Flex Track students are part-time and required to attend a set schedule of classes for their first two semesters. At the end of the first year of coursework, students must pass the First-Year Law Students' Exam (FYLSX) in order to continue in the JD program.

## What is the FYLSX?

The FYLSX is an exam offered by the State Bar of California that tests your knowledge of typical first-year law classes (Torts, Contracts, and Criminal Law) through multiple-choice and essay questions. ## How much does the program cost?

Tuition follows that of our regular program, which is \$995/unit. The first year of Flex Track tuition, plus fees, is \$19,610, and includes FYLSX prep materials from Fleming's Fundamentals of Law, Academic Support services, and FYLSX prep workshops. The cost of the FYLSX is approximately \$800 and is the student's responsibility. Federal financial aid is available.

## What is required to be considered for Flex Track?

Flex Track applicants follow the same admission process as regular applicants. Applicants who do not meet the requirements for admission as a regular student will be considered for Flex Track automatically. Only those who demonstrate potential for success and dedication to hard work will be admitted.

## What if I have not taken the LSAT?

Applicants who have not taken the LSAT will be considered for admission, but the quality of other application components will be emphasized.
