

# JD Flex Track 2021-2022

## ACADEMIC PROGRAM

To fulfill our commitment to making legal education accessible, we offer a special program to allow students who do not meet our normal admission requirements to attend law school. Flex Track students are part-time and required to attend a set schedule of classes for their first two semesters. At the end of the first year of coursework, students who do not earn a GPA of 2.67 or higher, or who do not score at least 145 on the LSAT in the first Flex term along with at least a C in each course, must pass the First-Year Law Students' Exam (FYLSX) in order to continue in the JD program.

## WHAT IS THE FYLSX?

The FYLSX is an exam offered by the State Bar of California that tests your knowledge of typical first-year law classes (Torts, Contracts, and Criminal Law) through multiple-choice and essay questions. Additional information about the FYLSX is available at [tls.edu/FYLSX](http://tls.edu/FYLSX).

## HOW MUCH DOES THE PROGRAM COST?

Tuition follows that of our regular program, which is \$1,035/unit. The first year of Flex Track tuition, plus fees, is \$20,330, and includes FYLSX prep materials from Fleming's Fundamentals of Law, Academic Support services, and FYLSX prep workshops. The cost of the FYLSX is approximately \$800 and is the student's responsibility. Federal financial aid is available.

## WHAT IS REQUIRED TO BE CONSIDERED FOR FLEX TRACK?

Flex Track applicants follow the same admission process as regular applicants. Applicants who do not meet the requirements for admission as a regular student will be considered for Flex Track automatically. Only those who demonstrate potential for success and dedication to hard work will be admitted.

## WHAT IF I HAVE NOT TAKEN THE LSAT?

Applicants who have not taken the LSAT will be considered for admission, but the quality of other application components will be emphasized.



## WHAT WOULD MY SCHEDULE LOOK LIKE?

All required courses are offered either on campus in the evenings or 100% online. You may select a hybrid schedule as well, with some classes online and others on campus.

The majority of online flex coursework is completed independently by the student. Live sessions via video conferencing are required at specific times. Live sessions ensure that information studied independently is sufficiently comprehended. Law school is demanding, and regular live guidance throughout the program is necessary for future Bar exam success. These live sessions will be held on weeks 1, 2, 3, 5, 7, 11, 13, and 14 of the semester.
