FLEX TRACK

We're committed to making a legal education accessible

To further that mission, we offer a special way for students who do not meet our regular admission standards to be considered for admission through our Flex Track.

Flex Track students, who are part-time, must adher to a predetermined class schedule for their initial two semesters.

After the second semester, those who do not achieve a GPA of 2.67 or higher, score at least 145 on the LSAT during the first Flex semester, and earl at least a C in each course are required to pass the First-Year Law Students' Examination (FYLSX) to continue in the Regular JD program. Alternatively, to continue in the Regular JD program, students not dismissed may continue for an optional third semester of study but must earn a cumulative GPA of 2.67+ or pass the FYLSX.

Trinity will help you with one free LSAT prep class, or you can be considered for the Flex Track option. Flex Track allows you to start law school without meeting our regular admission requirements.







WHAT ARE THE APPLICATION

REQUIREMENTS?

Requirements

All applicants must satisfy the California State Bar's pre-legal education requirements prior to starting law school. In addition, the Trinity Law School Admissions Committee seeks candidates who demonstrate an ability to succeed in law school and on the bar exam. Several factors are considered as evidence for success. These include undergraduate GPA, LSAT score, ability to communicate with precision, career accomplishments, and letters of recommendation to attest to these criteria. TLS will follow up with contact(s) from the letters of recommendation to verify information. The committee reviews candidates year round on a rolling admissions basis.

OTHER FAQS

Can I transfer in?

If you wish to transfer to Trinity after attending another law school, you must satisfy the admission requirements for new students and provide an official transcript and letter of standing from your current law school. Students who are not in good standing, on probation, or have been academically dismissed are considered on a case-by-case basis.

What if I don't have an LSAT?

Trinity will help you with one free LSAT prep class, or you can be considered for the Flex Track option for the first year. See www.tls.edu/flex

Can I go to Trinity Law School if I'm not a Christian?

Yes, people of any faith or no faith are welcome to attend, and many do. Trinity is a place where rigorous debate and discussion are encouraged. However, all professors and staff are Christian and teach from a biblical understanding of the law.

What if I don't have a bachelor's degree?

As part of satisfying the California State Bar's pre-legal education requirements, you must meet one of the following:

- 1. Hold an AA/AS or higher degree
- 2. Complete 60 transferable college units
- 3. Take a specific series of College Level Examination Program (CLEP) exams

What if I am using LSAC's Credential Assembly Service (CAS)? Can I still apply?

Our admissions team will request your CAS report upon application. If you are not using CAS, we will order transcripts on your behalf with your signed release after application.





The Center for Human Rights provides a unique opportunity for Trinity Law students seeking real exposure in international law.

Winter Program

Cambodia

The Winter Human Rights Program is offered in Phnom Penh and Siem Reap, Cambodia. Through this course, students learn about the fight against human trafficking through economic development during a time of government evolution. Additionally, students learn about the Cambodian genocide through visits to the S-21 Prison, the Killing Fields, and the Cambodian Tribunal where Khmer Rouge perpetrators were prosecuted. Students also have the opportunity to return in the summer to intern with an NGO.

Summer Program

Europe

Offered each July in The Hague, Netherlands, and Strasbourg, France, the Summer Human Rights Institute is an advanced course in international and comparative human rights law taught by leading academics and practitioners from around the world. Students learn about international and regional human rights systems and examine the most important human rights issues from a Christian perspective. Students also visit human rights courts and other sites that contribute to the modern view of human rights law.

Our mission is to defend—without charge—the religious freedoms, parental rights, and other civil liberties of people who cannot defend themselves.

Professor Fired for His Faith

Pacific Justice Institute (PJI) secured a legal victory for Eric Thompson, a sociology professor at Moreno Valley College, who was fired for his discussions of "dangerous" conservative worldviews in his college classroom. PJI represented the professor in depositions, administrative hearings, and a multi-day arbitration conducted like a trial. The arbitrator, who found many of the claims against the tenured professor were unfounded, ruled in Thompson's favor.

Corona Street Case

One of the most common categories of cases PJI handles involves street preachers who are being harassed by local governments, sometimes even being arrested, notwithstanding First Amendment speech rights. In this case, PJI is representing a man who was given a ticket for open-air preaching.

Orange County Rescue Mission



The Clinic's mission at Orange County Rescue Mission (OCRM) is to serve the legal needs of the residents at the Village of Hope and the homeless population of the greater Orange County area.

Serving the Homeless

The Clinic serves the legal needs of the homeless population of the greater Orange County area through its mobile legal clinic. The Trinity Mobile Legal Clinic (see left) has a unique feature in that it is able to go directly to the marginalized of Orange County. Weekly, this Clinic frequents a parking lot facility in the Civic Center Plaza in Santa Ana, CA, where it administers legal aid/advice to those in need.

WHAT ARE TRINITY'S

ACCREDITATIONS?

Accreditation

Trinity Law School is accredited by the Committee of Bar Examiners of The State Bar of California.

Trinity Law School is a school of Trinity International University, which is accredited by the Higher Learning Commission of the North Central Association of Colleges and Schools. Trinity Law School's degreegranting authority is in connection with its students qualifying to take the California Bar Examination, and obtaining admission to the practice of law in California is based on accreditation by the Committee of Bar Examiners of The State Bar of California.

Sitting for the Bar

Except as provided in rule 4.30 of the Admissions Rules (legal education in a foreign state or country), completion of a professional law degree program at this law school other than for the Juris Doctor degree does not qualify a student to take the California Bar Examination or satisfy the requirements for admission to practice law in California. It may not qualify a student to take the bar examination or to satisfy requirements for admission to the practice of law in any other jurisdiction. A student intending to seek admission to practice law should contact the admitting authority in the jurisdictions where the student intends to qualify to sit for the bar examination or to be admitted to practice for information regarding their legal education requirements.



WHERE CAN I

PRACTICE LAW?

Practicing Law Outside California

Applicants intending to practice law in states other than California are encouraged to investigate the educational requirements, as well as the rules and regulations, governing admission to practice in those jurisdictions. Study at, or graduation from, this law school may not qualify a student to take the bar examination or be admitted to practice law in jurisdictions other than California. A student who intends to seek admission to practice law outside of California should contact the admitting authority in that jurisdiction for information regarding its education and admission requirements.

Practicing Law Inside California

Accredited by the Committee of Bar Examiners of The State Bar of California, the law program fulfills the requirements pertaining to admission to the practice of law in the state of California. Graduates are qualified to take the California Bar Examination.

Out-of-State Students

If you are coming to Trinity Law School from another state, you should secure suitable housing and transportation to ensure that these issues do not become an impediment to academic success. Trinity does not provide on-campus housing. However, there are several apartment complexes located near campus offering a range of rental rates, leasing, and amenities.

Students with Disabilities

Students with disabilities requiring special arrangements will be accommodated upon petition, with supporting documentation of the disability and upon approval of the registrar. Special accommodations will be carefully tailored to meet your documented need(s) in accordance with the Trinity Law School disability policy.

Academic Catalog

Academic policies and standards, in addition to those in this viewbook, are contained in the catalog, which is issued to each student at enrollment. In case of any conflict, the standards contained in the catalog are controlling. Students are responsible for knowing and complying with the policies and standards for the law school as well as the California State Bar's rules regulating admission to practice law in California. 




